## FAQs

### Week Long Section Leader Training

We no longer run week long Section Leader Training at Gilwell Park as all training is now managed and provided locally. There are no current plans to run any future courses.

### Trouble printing e-learning certificates

Some of the most common reasons for problems with e-learning or certificates not printing are

- The internet browser being used is blocking pop-ups (as, when the print button is selected, it appears as a pop-up screen). This can be resolved by clicking on the 'tools' icon in the top right hand corner of the page and then going to the 'pop-up blocker' in the drop down menu that appears and disabling it for this site.
- The internet browser that you're using, particularly Google chrome. When the e-learning was designed, this browser was still in its beta phase, so it wasn't built as compatible. Therefore, you may not be able to access some of the resources, and will need to use Internet Explorer or Firefox.
- Some people have set their own computer security settings high and it prevents the running of the e learning. To resolve this they need to:
  - In Internet Explorer click on the 'Tools' menu. Select 'Internet Options' from the drop-down menu. In the Internet Options box select the 'Advanced' tab. Scroll down to 'Security'. Tick 'Allow active content from CDs to run on My Computer'. Click 'OK'.

## Courses

### British Red Cross Trainer Training

British Red Cross Practical First Aid Trainer Training (RCC21): Gilwell Park, 12 – 15 April 2014.

This course is for adults who wish to provide first aid training to both young people and adults within The Scout Association. The course provides participants with a British Red Cross (BRC) Practical First Aid Trainer Certificate, allowing them to deliver both First Response courses, as well as BRC awards to other members of The Scout Association.

Cost of course:

- £230 Residential - Peter Harrison Lodge (includes all meals and accommodation)
- £410 Residential - Whitehouse (includes all meals and accommodation)
