### **Gateway Qualifications**

Gateway Qualifications (previously known as OCN Eastern Region) provides adult learners in relevant roles across the UK an opportunity to complete a credit-based qualification, which is flexible and accessible to all. This can be beneficial for individuals who wish to demonstrate the skills and knowledge they have gained within their role in Scouting.

The new qualification is titled Level 2 Certificate in Providing Voluntary Youth Services in The Scout Association (QCF). It is for those in Section Leader or Assistant Section Leaders roles to complete if they wish to, in addition to their Wood Badge.
