Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> December	<p><b><u>New Module 1 training for Executive Committee Members</u></b></p> <p>In the new year, we will be launching a new version of Module 1: Essential Information specifically for Executive Committee Members. This is to coincide with the changes in membership type for Executive Committee Members, which means that from the first AGM after 1st January 2016, those on an Executive Committee will be required to be either a member or associate member of the Scout Association. More information on these changes can be found <a href="#">here</a>. In addition, new Executive Committee members will be required to complete Module 1 for Executive Committee Members, which has been created specifically to cater for this.</p> <p>The training will be available as trainers' notes and an e-learning package and will cover similar content to the existing Module 1, with additional content specifically for Executive Committee Members.</p>	<p><b><u>Updates to Core Documents</u></b></p> <p>The core training documents, including the Adult's Personal File, Adult's Personal File for Section Leaders, Training Advisers Guide, Adult Training Scheme and Module Matrix have been updated to reflect changes made over the last 12 months. The changes include the review of modules 14 and 15, the corrections to module 19 and the new Module 1 for Executive Committee members.</p> <p>The updated versions of each will be available to download from Member Resources and to order from Scout Shops towards the end of January. A table of changes and update pages will also be available on the Members Resources area, detailing the changes that have been made. This should help learners and trainers to update their editions.</p>
