

MAKE YOUR OWN FILM

Relive the adventures of summer by re-enacting and filming your camp memories. Encourage your young people to develop their digital and performance skills in this nostalgic activity.

(Online activity)

Suitable for Cubs, Scouts and Explorers



You will need:

- A video recorder or phone with video recording capabilities
- Something to watch the videos on, such as a laptop or projector. Alternatively, follow the instructions to create your own iPhone projector
- Popcorn

Instructions

1. Open up a group discussion with your young people about a recent camp or expedition. Get them thinking about their favourite moments and activities.
2. Divide them into smaller groups and ask each group to decide on one moment from camp that they would like to re-enact.
3. In their groups they should think about whether they would like a Director or Creative Producer (these roles are well-suited to anyone not confident in their acting skills or for those with filmmaker aspirations).
4. Once they have practiced and are happy with their re-enactment, give each group a video recorder or smartphone to record their performance.
5. Once all the groups have finished recording, grab some popcorn and play the films they have made on the laptop or projector and enjoy the movie night.

Outcomes
