#### Compass Goes Live

Compass is on its way and will go live for Training Managers and Administrations one week after it launches, this August.

While the old membership system is closed, there will be a period of a few weeks where you will have no access to member data. We know the membership system is important for you to access in order to keep records up to date for members and would like to thank you for your patience whilst the transition is made.

Once Compass is live you will need to register to use it as your log in details will not transfer over. An email will be sent to you when it is time for you to register explaining how to do this. Once registered you will be able to access Compass and all the tools to manage your training administration including new features such as being able to validate multiple members for the same module at the same time and record ongoing learning.

### **Open College Network (OCN) Awards**

As previously communicated, changes are taking place to both of the OCN awards offered by The Scout Association. We are currently working together with the OCN to review the awards and transfer them to the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF).

The launch date for the new OCN portfolio and awards has been revised to 1 January 2015, rather than August 2014 as previously stated. This change is due to the development time required to create the new awards and also to coincide with the launch of the updated training for the programme refresh, which the revised awards will reflect.

The OCN Eastern Region, whom we work with, are changing their name to Gateway Qualifications. This won't affect the qualifications at all, but will mean that the Awarding body will now be Gateway Qualifications rather than OCN, which will be reflected on the certificates. ### **Bushcraft Training**

Bushcraft Training Course

Ferny Crofts Activity Centre, Hampshire, 11-12 October.

This two day training course aims to give participants knowledge in all aspects of bushcraft and allow them to deliver these activities to young people. It covers shelter building (in which you can choose to spend the night or bring a tent to stay in); fire lighting; backwoods cooking; knife, axe and saw work; and wood whittling.
