If you choose to volunteer, you can work directly with young people or in a support role as a team or individual. Vacancy board & cards kit

The idea of this kit is that you order an A2 poster with a set of cards for eight different vacancies which you can display six at a time on the poster within plastic wallets. This allows the user to take one of the cards for reference to contact you. You get eight copies of each card.

Vacancy poster

This is an A2 size poster printed on 3mm foam core board in colour with six clear plastic wallets stuck on allowing the A6 cards to be inserted into, allowing the potential volunteer to keep the details so they can contact you to fill the vacancy.

Vacancy cards

These are A6 size cards printed on 200gsm card in colour. There are eight different vacancy positions, with different vacancy descriptions pre-populated which you can personalise and modify on each of the eight cards. The example positions are Cleaner, Buyer, Record keeper, 2 x Helpers, Cook, Fundraiser and Administrator.

Create your own

To create your own Vacancy board and cards log into the Members' Area of www.scouts.org.uk Select: My Tools > Print Centre > Materials > Vacancy Boards and follow the on screen instructions.

Start recruiting

Display the board in your meeting place, in a prominent location where parents and visitors will see it. Keep the board up and update/restock the vacancy cards as required.
