By signing up, you will also get access to the ILM learning zone. This offers lots of online development tools, resources and magazines focused on leadership and management, which will help to develop your skills further. What's great about being recognised as a Development Programme is that there is no formal assessment required by the ILM, which means that there is no extra work for you. All you have to do is complete all of the Modules and Missions in the Young Leader Scheme.

The scheme costs £49, which includes registration, a certificate when you complete the course and access to the learning zone while you are taking part in the scheme.
